English	<p align="center"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>We will continue to practise our Phase 2 and 3 phonics letter sounds daily. We also need to be able to recognise, read and spell tricky words in our reading books. You can play some games like word bingo or a look, cover and write activity you can find on Twinkl, Phonics play or Top Marks</p>	<p align="center"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>When sharing a book let your child have a go at reading words or simple sentences. Discuss any new words your child may not know.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Can you write some facts about what you have learnt about dinosaurs? Get a grown to help if you need to.</p>
Maths	<p align="center"><u>Number</u></p> <p>Using objects make up a number story for subtraction. E.G. I have 5 biscuits and I eat 1, how many do I have left? Try to use the vocabulary take away, subtract and minus.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Measure</u></p> <p>Can you measure objects using a pen? Try measuring the table, a pair of trousers, the bin, a bed and a window sill for example. Add your own ideas if you like. Record your measurements in a chart.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Time</u></p> <p>Talk about and sequence your day, saying what happens first, next, then and last. Draw a picture to show each part of the day.</p>
Topic	<p align="center"><u>Physical</u></p> <p>Can you hop? How many times can you hop on your left leg? How many times can you hop on your right leg? Can you beat your last score? What's your highest score?</p>	<p align="center"><u>Understanding of the World</u></p> <p>Take a trip to the local library or use the internet to find out about Dinosaurs.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Creative</u></p> <p>Make a poster with the title 'How wonderful am I?' Draw a picture and tell a grown up all the wonderful things about you. Write them down yourself or ask for help.</p>

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
